worthy to be praised and exalted for ever.

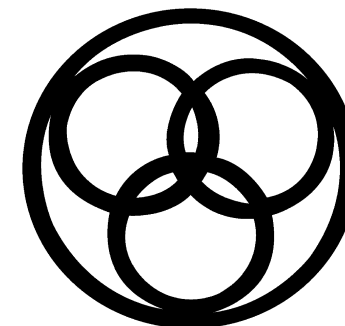
