- <sup>12</sup> For he that avenges blood has remembered the poor: he has not forgotten their cry.
- <sup>13</sup> The Lord has been merciful toward me, he saw what I suffered from my foes: he raised me up again from the gates of death,
- <sup>14</sup> That I might tell all your praises in the gates of Zion: that I might rejoice in your deliverance.
- <sup>15</sup> The nations have sunk into the pit they dug for others: in the very snare they laid is their foot taken;
- <sup>16</sup> The Lord has declared himself and upheld the right: the wicked are trapped in the work of their own hands.
