- ⁶ **Happy the man who has his quiver full of them: he will not be put to shame when he confronts his enemies at the gate.**

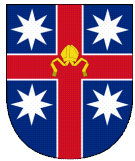
A Prayer at this Time

Diocese Vaccination Policy for Clergy & Volunteers

The Bishop in council encourages all eligible clergy, licensed lay ministers, officers, employees, volunteers, contractors, members and guests of the Diocese of Grafton and its various entities and activities to be vaccinated with an approved vaccine for COVID-19 except where they have been advised against such a vaccination by a registered medical practitioner. You should have received an email regarding this from the Diocese. If you did not, please see Nicola in the office for a copy.
Certain Ministries will require full vaccination and forms will need to be completed.
