- 2 **O Lord my God, I cried to you: and you have made me whole.**
- 3 You brought me back, O Lord, from the land of silence: you saved my life from among those that go down to the Pit.
- 4 **Sing praises to the Lord, all you his faithful ones: and give thanks to his holy name.**
- 5 For if in his anger is havoc, in his good favour is life: heaviness may endure for a night, but joy comes in the morning.
- 6 **In my prosperity I said 'I shall never be moved: your goodness, O Lord, has set me on so firm a hill.'**
- 7 Then you hid your face from me: and I was greatly dismayed.
- 8 **I cried to you, O God: and made my petition humbly to my Lord.**
- 9 'What profit is there in my blood, if I go down to the Pit: can the dust give you thanks, or declare your faithfulness?
- 10 **'Hear, O Lord, and be merciful: O Lord, be my helper.'**

A Parish Prayer for Growth

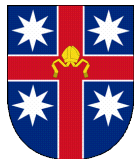
