Reflection

The Israelites demand a king as ruler instead of a judge – Samuel warns about the likely outcomes of that request, but the people did not listen. I think we can be like that sometimes and in the gospel we read of Matthew's calling and two healings - the hemorrhaging woman and the leader's daughter. Jesus calls Matthew to follow him and in turn the woman and the leader call on Jesus. It is a reminder that we are called to follow Jesus and to take that call out to the boundaries, just as Jesus was known and often challenged for his connections with tax collectors and others on the boundaries of society.

- Pray for the courage to listen and be challenged out of our comfort zone, to reflect Jesus' love and compassion, through words and actions.
- Give thanks for the work and witness of WontulpBi-Buya College in Cairns and Nungalinya College in Darwin.
