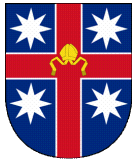

Today the Psalmist tells us to 'Give thanks to the Lord and call upon his name'. Some people like to focus on thankfulness by keeping a gratitude journal, in which they write down the things that they felt grateful for that day. It's a good way of taking notice of the small blessings all around us because each entry doesn't need to be for something extraordinary, like an overseas holiday. Most of them are likely to be for the small but special thing in life – a beautiful sunset, a good catch-up with a friend, a hobby enjoyed.
