which is life for evermore.



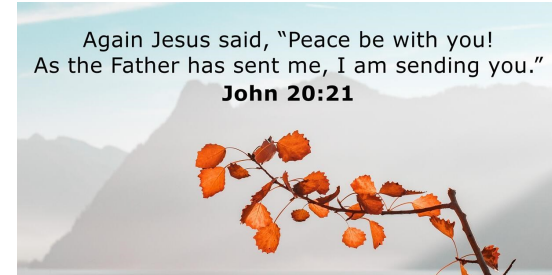
