

### Psalm 96

<sup>1</sup> O sing to the lord a new son: sing to the Lord, all the earth.  
<sup>2</sup> **Sing to the Lord and bless his holy name: proclaim the good news of his salvation from day to day.**  
<sup>3</sup> Declare his glory among the nations: and his wonders among all peoples.  
<sup>4</sup> **For great is the lord, and greatly to be praised: he is more to be feared than all gods.**  
<sup>5</sup> As for all the gods of the nations, they are mere idols: it is the Lord who made the heavens.  
<sup>6</sup> **Majesty and glory are before him: beauty and power are in his sanctuary.**  
<sup>7</sup> Render to the Lord, you families of the nations: render to the Lord glory and might.  
<sup>8</sup> **Render to the Lord the honour due to his name: bring offerings and come into his courts.**  
<sup>9</sup> O worship the Lord in the beauty of his holiness: let the whole earth stand in awe of him.  
<sup>10</sup> **Say among the nations that the lord is King: he has made the world so firm that it can never be moved; and he shall judge the peoples with equity.**  
<sup>11</sup> Let the heavens rejoice and let the earth be glad: let the sea roar, and all the fills it:  
<sup>12</sup> **Let the fields rejoice, and everything in them: then shall all the trees of the wood shout with joy before the Lord;**  
<sup>13</sup> For he comes, he comes to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with his truth.

<sup>1</sup> O sing to the Lord a new song: for he has done marvellous things;  
<sup>2</sup> **His right hand and his holy arm: they have got him the victory.**  
<sup>3</sup> The Lord has made known his salvation: he has revealed his just deliverance in the sight of the nations.  
<sup>4</sup> **He has remembered his mercy and faithfulness towards the house of Israel: and all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.**  
<sup>5</sup> Shout with joy to the Lord, all the earth: break into singing and make melody.  
<sup>6</sup> **Make melody to the Lord upon the harp: upon the harp and with the sounds of praise.**  
<sup>7</sup> With trumpets and with horns: cry out in triumph before the Lord, the king.  
<sup>8</sup> **Let the sea roar, and all that fills it: the good earth and those who live upon it.**  
<sup>9</sup> Let the rivers clap their hands: and let the mountains ring out together before the Lord;  
<sup>10</sup> **For he comes to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the peoples with equity.**
