- 6 **I call upon you, O God, for you will surely answer: incline your ear to me, and hear my words.**
- 7 Show me the wonders of your steadfast love, O saviour of those who come to you for refuge: who by your right hand deliver them from those that rise up against them.
- 16 **And I also shall see your face, because my cause is just: when I awake and see you as you are, I shall be satisfied.**
